1. What pieces of advice does the book give when shipwrecked?	<p><b>Set</b> your house in order.</p> <p><b>Prepare</b> for a battle to survive.</p> <p><b>Establish</b> a schedule (eat, keep watch, rest).</p> <p><b>Do not</b> drink urine or seawater.</p> <p><b>Keep</b> busy.</p> <p><b>Avoid</b> unnecessary exertion.</p> <p><b>Keep the mind</b> occupied with games.</p> <p><b>Lift the spirits by</b> singing and telling stories.</p>
2. What is the most important thing?	Do not lose hope.
3. What is the worst you will experience?	Seasickness
4. What are steps 1 to 3 of Pi's procedure?	<p><b>Step 1</b> Choose a day with moderate, regular waves.</p> <p><b>Step 2</b> To lessen the affect of the waves face the boat into the waves and blow the whistle soothingly.</p> <p><b>Step 3</b> Turn the boat sideways to the waves so it begins to rock more and blow the whistle more aggressively.</p>
5. What is step 4 in Pi's procedure?	<p><b>Step 4</b> <b>Disregard</b> steps 1 through 3.</p>
